## ORDER OF WORSHIP

INVOCATION P: Blessed be God: Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier!

**C: And blessed be God's Kingdom, now and forever. Amen!**

P: We gather together to worship:

### CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS

P: Let us call to mind the ways in which we have neglected to live as Jesus has commanded us.

{Silent reflections}

If you Lord should mark our iniquities, who among us could stand?

**C. But there is forgiveness with You, so that You may be revered.**

P: Rock of our hope,

**C. we confess that we live in opposition to your gracious will for us. We have failed to be a blessing for others by turning our backs on the needs of the poor, and on all those who are oppressed. We have been careless and neglectful by exploiting your creation and its creatures, without regard for the generations who will come after us. By our sins we are exiled from your Presence. We hunger and thirst for You; our bones are dried-up, and our hope is lost. Breathe your Spirit on us, O God, that we may live, and nurture our relationship with You, and with all that you have created.**

P: God's compassionate love is shown for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ suffered and died for us. In the name of, and for the sake of Christ, I proclaim to you that all your sins + are forgiven. In the waters of Baptism, we were joined with Christ, reborn as children of God, and anointed with God's Holy Spirit. We are free to live as God's people in the world, and are called to help bring forth God's Kingdom on earth. **C.**

THE CONFESSION OF FAITH

OFFERING PRAYER

P: Loving God,

**P: The Lord be with you. C: and also with you.**

**P: Lift up your hearts. C: We lift them to the Lord.**

**P: Let us give thanks to the Lord, our God. C: It is right to give our thanks and praise.**

### THE WORDS OF INSTITUTION

P: Holy, Mighty, and Merciful God: Endless is your mercy and everlasting is your faithfulness, enduring from age to age.....

Together as “the Body of Christ,” we proclaim his death until he comes again.

**ALL: Christ has died; Christ has risen; Christ will come again.**

P. With this bread and cup we remember your Son, the first-born of your new creation. We remember his life lived for others, and strive to model our lives after his.

**C: Amen. Come Lord Jesus.**

P: Holy God, Holy and Mighty, Holy and Compassionate, send upon us and this meal your Holy Spirit, whose breath revives us for life, whose fire rouses us to love. Enfold in your arms, all who share in this holy food. Nurture in us “the Fruits of the Spirit”, that we may be a living tree, sharing your bounty with all creation.

### THE LORD’S PRAYER

P: Lord, remember us in your Kingdom, and teach us to pray:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever and ever. Amen

THE DISTRIBUTION OF HOLY COMMUNION ~ {Please come forward via the center isle, and return to your seat by the side isles.}

P: Jesus said, “I am the Bread of Life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.” Come, for all who are present here are welcome at his banquet.

### THE PRAYER AFTER COMMUNION

P: Loving, sheltering God,

**C: In this meal, you sustain the weary, heal the broken, and re-ignite in us the awareness of your undying love. Strengthen us to live fully in this world, fearlessly setting an example by following the teachings of Jesus, your Son. Inspire us to be responsible stewards of all You have entrusted to us: ourselves, our families, our communities, all of creation, and all life. We pray in the name of Jesus, your Son. Amen.**
